- Students must author their own design.

Collaborative and plagiarized work will be disqualified.

- Students may submit only one entry.

- All entries must be clearly labeled on the back, upper left corner with the STUDENT'S FULL NAME, GRADE, SCHOOL NAME, and TEACHER'S FULL NAME. (Typed labels are highly recommended.) If an entry is not clearly labeled, it will be disqualified.

- All entries must be accompanied by one completed entry form.

- Entries must be on one 8.5 x 11-inch white colored paper – landscape or portrait format. Entries larger or smaller in size will be disqualified.

*It is recommended that the artwork fill as much of the paper as possible.
The winning design will be printed on a t-shirt.*
